The mission of the North Carolina Railway Museum, Inc. (NCRM) is to educate current and future generations in the exciting science, technology, and development of America's railroads while preserving the heritage of railroading, its connection to and social impacts on the land, people, and industries of North Carolina and our nation.

The NCRM was founded in **1963** as the East Carolina Chapter of the National Railway Historical Society, and in **1983** our chapter purchased the remaining portions of the heritage railroad originally envisioned by Roscoe Bonsal in **1904** as the New Hope Valley Railroad and we moved our equipment from Farmville to Bonsal, North Carolina. In **1984** we gave our first public ride and in **2008** we officially became a railway museum. Since **1983**, the NCRM has worked hard to provide enjoyment and education to all North Carolina communities. We are especially proud of our work with school and children's groups, special needs groups, senior groups, and many others.

### Into our next 60-years, our core values remain:



**Restore** – rebuilding and presenting to our visitors and communities historic railroading equipment in working condition in all its original power, glory, and pride.




**Preserve** – bringing awareness and understanding of the heritage of railroading and its impact on our culture and society with an emphasis of a more sustainable tomorrow for all.



**Engage** – enriching the lives of our visitors, members, and community through our full-scale, live demonstration of railroading with all its excitement, knowledge, and skills.

# YOUR SPONSORSHIP SUPPORTS THE MUSEUM'S EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS, PRESERVATION, MUSEUM CURATION, AND PRESERVATION AND RESTORATION PROJECTS INCLUDING ANY OF THE FOLLOWING (AMONG MANY OTHER ACTIVITIES):

- Preservation and restoration of our **1916 Pullman Atlantic Coast Line Baggage Express car #704 (#1665 current configuration)** where we will display a rare collection of dining car and other railroad memorabilia as well as more railroad history to view (Estimated Cost: \$200K).
- Completion of its 15-year rebuild of our **1941 Vulcan Ironworks Steam Locomotive #17** in 2024 bringing steam power back to our trains (Estimated Cost: \$150K).
- Restoration and renovation of the **1884 Goldston Freight Depot** by providing public accessibility, a passenger platform (deck), fire protection and lighting to finish our interior interactive exhibit space (Estimated Cost: \$125K).
- Installation of security fencing around many of our historic railroad pieces in our Maintenance of Way Yard (Estimated Cost: \$65K).
- Renovation of our ever-popular **1922 Southern Railway Post Office (RPO) and Baggage car** with a much-needed fresh coat of paint and lettering (Estimated Cost: \$15K).


